# POLICE SNIPER TRAINING

This three-day class hosted by the Springfield Police Academy focuses on refreshing the skills of certified snipers. The class is intended for Police Officers who are current snipers on their department's SWAT/Tactical Team or ILEAS WMD / Mobile Field Force Snipers.

Shooting scenarios this year are focused on challenging the sniper's ability to adapt to various shooting positions as well as timed events. There is a full day of stations designed around precision rifle shooting. Stations will consist of shooting past the typical 100-yard line. A police sniper scenario will be included that is designed to stress the sniper with decision making and a timed shot. Snipers will also be afforded plenty of time to shoot long range out to, and beyond 1000 yards. The three days will wrap up with a three gun course.

Snipers will be required to bring a rifle that is capable of shooting a 1" group at 100 yards. Sniper rifles will need a quality optic with a Mil Dot reticule or other scale. All snipers should bring all their regular Observer/Sniper gear that is needed for the full spectrum of range operations and weather conditions. There will be no field craft exercise during this class. Snipers are encouraged to bring **300 rounds of "match grade" ammunition 50 rounds carbine ammunition and 50 rounds of pistol ammunition.**
