length will include criminal sexual sadism, necrophilia, bestiality, cannibalism, and some of the rarest and remarkably violent and perverse sexual deviancies ever perpetrated.

Sexual homicide case studies and crime scene photos, interview samples of serial killers, videos of violent pornography and overall mindset of criminal sexual sadists and serial killers discussed.

The primary objective is to obtain a more comprehensive understanding of the general mindset and psychosocial backgrounds of serial killers and criminal sexual sadists in an effort to identify and better prepare for interviews and case preparation.

COURSE CONTENT:

This course offers extensive examination into the minds of convicted murderers, who primary motive is sex-related and who primarily target women and children. The fundamental motivations of some of the most common and rare violent paraphilic behaviors will be explored along with extensive case studies of famous and not so famous serial murderers. This course breaks down the development and progression of necrophilia, lust murder, sexual sadism, and serial murder typologies and the path toward problematic behaviors, including the onset of criminal activity and addictive processes through the use of the internet and other means.

- 10) Criminal Sexual Sadism, Necrophilia and Cannibalism (worldwide case samples)
- 11) Sexual Homicide Case Illustrations
- 12) Role of Fantasy and Signature analysis in crime scenes
- 13) Investigative considerations and interview strategies (case samples and Russell Williams's Confession)
- 14) Dr. Simon's Research Presentation on Psychological Aspects of Serial Sexual Homicide & Theoretical Perspectives of Weapon Selection: Behavioral Profiles of Men Who Were Convicted of 1st Degree Pre-Meditated Murder Using Knives Compared to Firearms Implementing Structured Interview Techniques, Projective Drawings and Rorschach Ink-Blot Test.
