Developed and Instructed By: Ron Yanor, Adamax Inc. Ron Yanor is the training director & President of Adamax Tactical Academy Inc. He spent 18+ years on a multi-agency tactical unit while working for Sangamon County Sheriff's Department; with the last nine years as the unit's training and intelligence officer. During that tenure, he authored two state training board certified SWAT courses and was instrumental in the development of a tactical medic program. Since 1999, Ron has been a contract trainer and consultant. He has authored dozens of nationally published articles on tactics and training. His instructor certifications are in various aspects of tactical and high risk environments. Ron has worked at various locations in North America and assisted with training at TEES Brazil. He is also active as a consultant on school security issues. Ron has a B.S. Degree in Education, and was a competitive shooter with a national title.

About the Course: This class is designed to certify the individual officer for SWAT tactics at the entry level using the CQB philosophy. Upon graduation, the student will perform the basic tasks required of a SWAT team. Veteran tactical officers can also benefit from tactics and methods taught. Patrol level officers can also apply these techniques to their daily duties and will be able to act as a liaison to a tactical team in event of an emergency in their jurisdiction.

Class topics include communications, dynamic entries, systematic entries, bus assaults, team movements & numerous practical exercises. A cadre of trained instructors will teach each class. There will be a night exercise on Thursday and dark clothing will be needed. Both a written and practical exam are given at the end of the course. This 40 hour class is State Training Board certified (for certificate only).

Although there is no prerequisite physical standard, endurance & stamina are an asset. Many classes require regular physical activity. Several classes (defensive tactics & mid-level entry) require moderate levels of exertion.

Required Student Materials: The class is held regardless of weather, so appropriate clothing is suggested. Although not required, BDU style or other loose clothing is also suggested. The student's duty leather & ballistic vest will suffice, but will be subjected to rigorous activity. A loaner gas mask will be provided if needed. Students are encouraged to bring any other

equipment they feel they may need. Please bring all the equipment you need, including ammunition on the first day. Students should bring a cooler with plenty of drinks and a sack lunch and snacks due to the remote training site.
