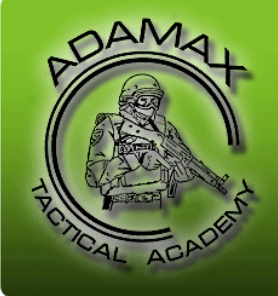

# BASIC RAPID DEPLOYMENT

**Course Objective:** The objective of this course is to enable uniformed officers to effectively deal with an active shooter in a school or other public building. Focus is on the initial deployment and reaction to an in-progress crisis, using the “diamond formation”. Students will be able to form a small, multi-agency emergency action team to perform essential tasks, react to immediate threats, and interact with tactical operators. The goal is to enable departments to work together during a crisis with common basic procedures and tactics.

- Deployment Theory & Tasks
- Weapons Handling & Preparation
- Active Threat Response
- Room Clearing
- Basic Formations
- Actions at Danger Areas
- Situational Training Exercise
- Casualty Handling

**Students should bring:** Duty Leather, Duty Pistol (unloaded), and a flashlight.
