Instructor: Mr. Kevin F. Burke. Mr. Burke is an attorney with a broad background in law enforcement, prosecution, and law related instruction to in-service law enforcement professionals. Mr. Burke has served as an attorney with the Office of Chief Counsel of the United States Customs Service and, in that capacity, instructed and advised Special Agents and Inspectors while assigned to the U.S. Customs Service Academy located at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Glynco, Georgia. He has instructed at both the graduate and undergraduate levels and has taught at universities and colleges in Illinois and Minnesota. He was a law instructor at the University of Illinois Police Training Institute. Mr. Burke served as a supervisor and prosecuting attorney in the Du Page County, Illinois State's Attorney's Office. He served for seven years as a Special Agent with the United States Secret Service, assigned to the Chicago field office, where he conducted criminal and intelligence investigations.
