Instructor: Attorney Kevin Burke is well known throughout the state for his legal outlines and instruction on a variety of topics relevant to Illinois peace officers. He has a broad background in law enforcement, prosecution, and law related instruction to in-service law enforcement professionals.

Mr. Burke served as an attorney with the Office of Chief Counsel of the U.S. Customs Service. In that capacity he instructed and advised Special Agents and Inspectors while assigned to the U.S. Customs Service Academy at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Glynco (GA). He was a legal instructor at the University of Illinois Police Training Institute and has taught federal money laundering law for the U.S. Treasury Department's Fraud and Financial Crimes program.

Mr. Burke served as a supervisor and prosecuting attorney in the DuPage County (IL) State's Attorney's Office. He served for seven years as a Special Agent with the U.S. Secret Service, assigned to the Chicago field office where he conducted criminal and intelligence investigations.

Course Includes: This course will provide a comprehensive examination of search and seizure law in a manner that integrates and reconciles new cases with existing doctrine. Both days will be devoted exclusively to search and seizure issues, allowing ample opportunity for student-instructor interaction.
