The Department of Homeland Security has indicated that the National Incident Management System (NIMS) concepts and principles and Incident Command System (ICS) for incident management must be used and implemented in day to day emergency operations by all state and local jurisdictions and tribal governments as a condition for the receipt of preparedness funding from all federal departments and agencies.
