He is the author of the State Cyber Crimes Law, who also served on the DCFS Death Review Team (96-02). He conducts several other trainings, such as NASRO, IL MTU, Suburban Law Enforcement Academy, NCJTC, ICAC, ILETSB Firearms Instructor, SWAT Defensive Tactics Instructor and ASP Trainer.

Course Description – The phenomenon of the school shooter in our schools is at an all-time high. With the advent of depression, bullying and suicidal tendencies as a result, first responders in our school and police departments must be trained to handle these situations with immediacy and GREAT sensitivity. The goal MUST be to identify and intercept the criminal activity before the school shooter is able to take action. The goal of this training is to empower school administrators and Law Enforcement how to gather digital evident against the aggressor so they may find out who the perpetrator is and take action immediately after the comment or posting is made by the aggressor. The LEO/ School Administrator will learn the fundamentals of investigating social media and internet related crimes that deal with domestic terrorism. We will use the Electronics Communication Privacy Act (ECPA) to our advantage in identifying the person responsible for posting the online threats BEFORE the shooter has the opportunity to kill our children.
